### DISCRIPTION

Discover the mystical kingdom of Bhutan, a land of breathtaking beauty, pristine culture, and warm hospitality. Visit the charming cities of Thimphu, Punakha, and Paro, and immerse yourself in the country's unique blend of traditional and modern charm. Explore majestic fortress monasteries, ancient temples, and sacred sites, including the iconic Paro Taktsang (Tiger's Nest Monastery), and discover the vibrant culture, rich history, and stunning natural beauty of Bhutan, from lush valleys and towering mountains to picturesque villages and traditional farms, with a 5-night journey through Thimphu (2N), Punakha (1N), and Paro (2N).

### Geography and Climate

Bhutan, a small country nestled in the Himalayas, boasts a diverse geography with towering mountains, lush forests, and picturesque valleys. The country's climate varies greatly depending on the altitude, with subtropical temperatures in the south and cold, snowy winters in the north. The four distinct seasons bring different experiences, from the rhododendron blooms of spring to the warm summers, harvest-filled autumns, and serene winters, making Bhutan a year-round destination for nature lovers and adventure seekers.

### Day 1: Arrival in Bhutan and Transfer to Thimphu

Begin your journey to Bhutan with a breathtaking mountain flight from India. As you fly into the Himalayas, witness the world's highest peaks from the left side of the aircraft, with your pilot announcing the names of the mountains if the weather permits.

Descend into the high mountains and take in the stunning views of the Paro Valley, with its lush alpine forests, quaint monasteries, temples, and traditional farmhouses. Catch a glimpse of the fertile Paro Valley, the majestic Paro Dzong, and the meandering Paro Chu river before landing at Paro International Airport.

Upon arrival, our representative will greet you and assist with your transfer to Thimphu, the capital city of Bhutan. Check-in to your hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure, exploring the city or relaxing in your hotel.

Overnight stay in Thimphu.

### Day 2: Thimphu City Sightseeing

After breakfast, embark on a full-day city tour of Thimphu, exploring its iconic landmarks and cultural attractions.

Visit the revered National Memorial Chorten, a stupa dedicated to the third king of Bhutan, and marvel at the impressive Buddha statue. Next, stop at the Takin Zoo, home to the national animal of Bhutan, the takin.

Drive downhill and pause at the junction to admire the majestic Trashichho Dzong, a stunning fortress monastery that serves as the seat of the government.

Continue to the National Library, which houses a vast collection of ancient Buddhist texts and manuscripts, and the Folk Heritage Museum, showcasing the traditional Bhutanese way of life.

In the afternoon, take a leisurely stroll to the Handicraft Bazaar, where you can witness artisans at work and shop for traditional handicrafts.

Spend the late afternoon at leisure, exploring the city's main streets, shopping for souvenirs, or simply relaxing in a local café.

Return to your hotel in the evening and enjoy an overnight stay in Thimphu.

### **Day 3: Thimphu to Punakha**

After breakfast, depart for the scenic Punakha Valley, driving through the majestic Dochula Pass (10,000 ft). Stop at the charming Hongtsho village and the immigration checkpoint to stamp your permit.

As you cross the pass, marvel at the stunning 108 Druk Wangyal chortens, adorned with colorful prayer flags. Descend into the picturesque Punakha Valley, passing through Thinleygang village and Lobesa.

Take a short walk through the villages to visit the revered Chimmi Lhakhang, a temple dedicated to the "Divine Madman," Drukpa Kinley. Later, explore the majestic Punakha Dzong, strategically located at the confluence of the Pho Chu and Mo Chu rivers.

Arrive at your hotel in Punakha and spend the rest of the evening at leisure. Overnight stay in Punakha.

### **Day 4: Punakha to Paro via Thimphu**

After breakfast, depart for Paro, driving via Thimphu. Stop at Lampelri and visit the serene Royal Botanical Park, home to a diverse range of flora and fauna. Spend 30 minutes exploring the park, where you may spot red pandas, various bird species, and take photos by the natural lake. You may also have the opportunity to watch a short documentary about the park.

Continue your drive to Paro, passing through Semtokha, and transfer to your hotel upon arrival. Check-in and spend the rest of the day at leisure, relaxing or exploring Paro's charming town.

Overnight stay in Paro.

#### **Day 5: Paro Sightseeing Tour**

After breakfast, embark on a full-day sightseeing tour of Paro, exploring its iconic landmarks and cultural attractions.

Visit the majestic Paro Dzong, a fortress monastery that dates back to the 17th century. Next, explore the National Museum, housed in the round fortress of Ta Dzong, which showcases a fine collection of natural and historic artifacts, making it one of the best natural history museums in Asia.

In the afternoon, visit the Paro Penlop Heritage Farmhouse, which offers a glimpse into traditional Bhutanese farming practices. Stop by the ruins of Drukgyel Dzong, a 17th-century fortress that once protected the kingdom from Tibetan invaders. Explore the ancient Kyichu Lhakhang, one of the oldest and most sacred monasteries in Bhutan, dating back to the 7th century.

Later, transfer to the base of the iconic Taktsang (Tiger's Nest) Monastery, one of the most revered spiritual heritage sites in Bhutan.

Spend the rest of the day at leisure, exploring Paro's charming town, shopping for souvenirs, or simply relaxing in a local café.

Return to your hotel in the evening and enjoy an overnight stay in Paro.

#### **Day 6: Departure from Paro**

After a delicious breakfast, bid farewell to the enchanting kingdom of Bhutan as you transfer to Paro International Airport for your onward flight, carrying back memories of your unforgettable journey.
