Overnight in Hanoi, ready to continue your Vietnamese adventure tomorrow.

Day 2: Hanoi to Ha Long Bay Overnight Cruise

Depart Hanoi for Ha Long Bay, a stunning Natural World Heritage Site recognized by UNESCO. Upon arrival at the Cruise Port, receive a warm welcome from the cruise staff and check-in for your overnight cruise.

Embark on a journey to discover the breathtaking beauty of Ha Long Bay, characterized by thousands of limestone rocks and karst grottoes. Savor a delicious lunch on board, then explore the bay's hidden gems, including ancient grottos, pristine beaches, and floating villages.

Day 4: Hanoi to Ho Chi Minh City

In Hanoi, your driver will pick you up and transfer you to Noi Bai Airport for your flight to Ho Chi Minh City (flight tickets excluded).

Upon arrival in Ho Chi Minh City, also known as Saigon, you'll be welcomed by your local tour guide and transferred to the city center. Check-in to your hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 5: Ho Chi Minh City Tour

Begin the day with breakfast at your hotel, then depart for a morning city tour.

Visit the Independence Palace, a historic landmark and witness to the Vietnam War. Explore the grand building, now a museum and reception hall. Continue to the beautiful Notre Dame Cathedral, a French colonial-era structure, and the historic Central Post Office, one of the city's major landmarks. Next, visit the War Remnants Museum, a poignant reminder of the

country's turbulent past. Gain insight into the Vietnamese perspective on the war and the nation's struggle for independence. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, savoring traditional Vietnamese cuisine.

In the afternoon, drive to the Cu Chi Tunnels, a network of underground tunnels that played a vital role in the war. Explore the tunnels, learning about their construction and significance. Experience the thrill of firing a rifle (optional) and gain a deeper understanding of the war and its impact on the nation. Return to Ho Chi Minh City in the evening and overnight at your hotel.

Day 6: Mekong Delta Day Trip

Visit the historic Vinh Trang Pagoda, dating back to the 19th century. Then, board a sampan and cruise through the picturesque islands of the Mekong Delta, including Dragon, Unicorn, Phoenix, and Tortoise islands. Stop at Unicorn Island to stroll through orchards, enjoy tropical fruits, and experience traditional folk music. Visit a local fruit plantation and ride a hand-rowed sampan through the serene Thoi Son canal. Interact with local villagers, visit a honey-bee farm, and sample honey tea and coconut candy. Savor a delicious lunch at a local restaurant.

In the afternoon, choose to cycle through Tan Thach village, immersing yourself in local daily life, or relax in a hammock, enjoying the cool breeze. Return to Ho Chi Minh City in the late afternoon, with memories of the Mekong Delta's natural beauty and rich culture. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 7: Ho Chi Minh City to Siem Reap

Spend the morning at leisure until checking out of your hotel. Your driver will then transfer you to the airport for your flight to Siem Reap (flight tickets excluded). Upon arrival in Siem Reap, you'll be greeted and driven to your hotel for check-in. In the afternoon, visit the Senteurs D'Angkor New Workshop, where local artisans create handmade soap, cosmetics, and spices. Observe the preparation of traditional curry and amok, and sample local flavors like flavored coffee and tea. Next, visit Wat Bo, a respected pagoda founded in the 18th century, featuring unique wall paintings of the Reamker (Ramayana). End the day at Psar Chars, Siem Reap's lively "Old Market", where you can find everything from souvenirs to local delicacies. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 8: Explore Angkor Thom and Angkor Wat

Begin the day with breakfast at your hotel, then set out to explore the ancient city of Angkor Thom. Visit the South Gate of Angkor Thom, also known as "Big Angkor", a 3km² walled and moated royal city that was the last capital of the Angkorian Empire. Discover the famous

Bayon Temple, a masterpiece of Khmer architecture, and the Terrace of the Elephants, an impressive 300-meter-long wall adorned with carved elephants. Explore the Royal Palace Area, Phimeanakas, and the Terrace of the Leper King, featuring intricate carvings and mythological beings. Next, visit the enchanting Ta Prohm Temple, a testament to the power of nature, with its crumbling stones and vines. In the afternoon, explore the magnificent Angkor Wat Temple, one of the wonders of the oriental world. Marvel at its awe-inspiring ruins, decorative details, and architectural style, a testament to the achievements of Southeast Asia's greatest civilization.

Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 9: Departure

Spend the morning at leisure until checking out of your hotel.

Your driver will then transfer you to the airport for your departure flight, bringing an end to your unforgettable journey through Vietnam and Cambodia.
