Description

The region features a mix of landscapes, from a bustling city in the northwest along a major river surrounded by mountains, to a small crescent-shaped island with tree-lined avenues, a hilly landscaped garden amid forests, and a coastal city with beaches, mountains, and harbors. The climate varies from cold, dry winters and hot, humid summers inland, to milder winters and warm, humid summers along the coast, with occasional snow in winter. The best time to visit is generally in spring or autumn for pleasant weather, scenic views, and seasonal highlights such as flower blooms, autumn foliage, or winter light displays.

Geography and Climate

Located in the northwest along a major river, surrounded by mountains, with cold, dry winters and hot, humid summers; best visited in spring or autumn. A small crescent-shaped island on a river with tree-lined avenues; cold winters with snow, mild summers; ideal in spring, autumn, or snowy winter. Day 1 Arrival in Seoul

Arrive at **Incheon International Airport**, one of the world's most efficient and modern airports. After clearing immigration, transfer to your hotel in Seoul by shared coach. Spend the day settling in and soaking up the city's vibrant energy. Seoul perfectly blends modern skyscrapers with historic palaces and traditional neighborhoods. You can take a stroll around nearby areas or simply relax at your hotel. Overnight stay in Seoul.

Day 2 | Royal Seoul Heritage & Hanbok Experience

You can explore **Myeongdong Shopping Street**, famous for fashion and street food, or relax at your hotel. Overnight stay in Seoul.

Day 8 Seoul – Departure

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and transfer to **Incheon International Airport** for your flight back home. Take home beautiful memories of South Korea, from its royal heritage and modern cityscapes to scenic islands, gardens, and coastal charm.
